

## MK 1 Nerve Agent Antidote Kit Protocol:

The Mark 1 antidote kit shall be used **ONLY** for known, or highly suspected exposure to chemical nerve agents and with the presence of symptoms of nerve agent toxicity.

High suspected means a known terror attack in the form of a bomb or other explosive detonation **OR** as a known intentional release of a possible chemical agent.

The predominant symptoms of nerve agent exposure are as follows:

Onset	Minutes to One hour
Eyes	Small pupils, bloodshot eyes
Nose	Severe runny nose
Lungs	Wheezing and increased sputum production
Neuro	Muscle spasm, twitching and rigid paralysis
Skin	Sweating

Treatment Protocol (Use **BOTH** injectors):

Protect yourself with PPE

Symptom	Exposed < 15 minutes prior	Exposed > 15 minutes prior
Small pupils, runny nose	One (1) Mark 1 kit	None
Mild SOA	Two (2) Mark 1 kits	One (1) Mark 1 kit
Moderate/Severe SOA	Three (3) Mark 1 kits	Two (2) Mark 1 kits

The injectors may not penetrate when wearing bunker gear, so this must be removed.

Inject antidote kits into thigh muscle

***Seek immediate medical attention after administering Mark 1 kits!!!!***
